**Pastor's Reflection**

Next Sunday, July 9<sup>th</sup> at the 11:15 Mass, Fr. Colin King OFM is going to be celebrating a Mass of Thanksgiving here. Fr. King was ordained on Sat. June 10<sup>th</sup> as a Franciscan Friar for the Province of St. John the Baptist at St. Clement Church in Cincinnati, Ohio. Fr. King is from Seton Parish and his parents, Norah and Tunney King are active members of our parish. Following his Mass, the parish will host a reception for Fr. Colin. In a few short weeks, Fr. Colin will be leaving for his first assignment as a missionary in Jamaica. In lieu of any personal gifts, Fr. Colin suggests a gift to **Get Kids to School, c/o Friar Works Office, 1615 Vine St., Cincinnati, Ohio 45202-6400**. Fr. Colin has assisted us for many years at Christmas and Easter liturgies when he came for vacation. He has persevered on a long road and it is my hope and prayer that as Fr. Colin serves in the mission fields, we the parishioners of Seton Parish can stay connected with him and support him with our prayers and outreach. We look forward to celebrating with him here at his home parish next Sunday morning.

As of July 1<sup>st</sup>, Deacon Hector Raymond is making an adjustment to his schedule here in the parish. Deacon Hector as many of you know has been an employed staff member here for many years. For many years he was a full-time employee on our staff and more recently he felt the need to reduce his hours to part-time. Deacon Hector recently spoke with me and requested that he step away from the parish as an employee and still serve in the capacity as a deacon in the parish. His assignment here now will be as all deacons for the most part are in the diocese. This was the way Deacon Joe Checca served us here in the parish when he was with us.

Deacon Hector has both the support of the Bishop as well as my support in this change. I would say that for the average parishioner, you will not notice any change, as Deacon Hector is still going to be very present on weekends and present at liturgical services and serve as a deacon here at Seton Parish. He will not be here as many hours as he has been in the past and he will be spending more time with his family.

Just a reminder again that beginning on Monday July 3<sup>rd</sup>, we are going to be doing some major work in the chapel. The chapel is going to be closed for three weeks. The official closing time will be this Sunday evening at 10:00 p.m. We are going to have to completely remove all the furnishings from the chapel because the construction workers will be here at the crack of dawn on Monday morning. There were portions of the Jerusalem Stone that were not cut properly that must be taken up and replaced. In addition, the flooring beneath the carpeting needs redone, and that is the reason why that portion of the floor creaks so badly now. It was all done in a hurry and as the saying goes "haste makes waste." Finally, there are exposed seams in the pillars that need to be finished and repainted. You will notice that a lot of the concrete work on the walk ways was completed this week. We continue whittling away at problems as they emerge.
