



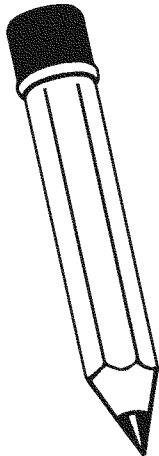
Jesus told His listeners that like the bridesmaids with the bridegroom, no one knows when the Son of Man (Jesus) will return.
