Minutes:

August/September minutes approved by All Motioned by Matt Forshey & seconded by Lori Cunningham.

We opened the formal meeting at 7:30 with a prayer and discussion led by Deacon Hector.

Sub-Commission Updates:

Music: All is going well. We have more youth for our choirs.

Art & Environment: Wannitta has no report this month. She will discuss with Father what kind of Advent wreath to use for the Worship Center (PAC). Simplicity of flowers for the renovated space until the blessing and rededication of the renovated worship space. Deacon Hector is checking with Gloryandpraisevestments.com for estimates for Altar cloths and vestments (Green & White for now).

Youth: The only report is that we have a Mass at 6:45 on Sunday evening. SPY Ministries. Looking for a second under classman to represent SPY

Ushers: Welcoming new usher Mike Glanzman. Working out issue with communion distribution at the 8 am Mass. John Samborski coordinating.

Greeters: All is well. Lori has asked Deacon Hector to uncheck the bind family option for minister assignments. We have had too many families requesting subs and when they are assigned as families it has become extremely difficult to fill those spaces especially if the family is involved in the many ministries.

Lectors/EM/Servers: EM training is required by the diocese every three years and we are now due. All Extraordinary Ministers are required to take this training. This training was held on the 1st and 2nd of October. For those who could not make the training, a video is available on the EMCH Group Page on our website. The commissioning date will have to be coordinated with Fr. Jim. Servers will not be

accepted for training until they begin the 4th grade.

Altar Server Training was held on September 17, 2016, 10 – 12 Noon, Worship Center (PAC). Five servers were trained and will need to be blessed at a mass. The Altar Server Picnic was held on September 24, 2016, 10 – 12 Noon. We had about 20 servers and parents attend. A huge thank you to the Knights of Columbus for providing the food and cooking for the event.

Commissioning and Blessing is scheduled for the Masses of **October 29 & 30**. All EMHCs will be re-commissioned and other ministers will be blessed. This has been placed in the bulletin and a message will be going out to all affected ministers.

Children's Liturgy of the Word: No change until we are in the newly renovated worship space.

Renovation Steering Committee (RSC): This Committee has finished its planning stage and is now involved with helping with the planning and logistics of the move to the renovated worship space. This will involve furnishings and other items and issues directed by Fr. Jim. Fr. Jim has checked with the diocese and Bishop Campbell is available for the consecrating and blessing of the new altar and worship spaces. We are looking at January 4th for the celebration. This is the feast date of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton. Father is planning on setting up a dedication Committee and he would like the Liturgy Commission to assist with the Liturgy and reception.

Old Business:

Renovation: On-going. We will keep you posted.

New Business:

Anointing of the Sick at the 5, 8, & 9:30 a.m. Masses on 12 & 13 November. (In the bulletin).

Dedication and Reception Committees. Father Jim is looking at forming a dedication committee consisting of Parish life and others with the Knights coordinating the reception

Concerns of the members:

Deacon Hector is still looking for someone to take over the minutes. It is difficult to capture all the information during the meeting. That would be a great help. Let Deacon Hector know if you would like to assist.

Frank Piper, via email: The only thing I keep bringing up with Wayne is, what is our plan for Christmas Masses if we are NOT back in the Renovated Church in time? All I keep hearing is, "We will be". With the announcement of being back one week before Christmas, it's way too close for comfort. It's best to have a plan now that will not be used, rather than running around in a panic. My thoughts, if Mass must be held in the Worship Center, is to increase the number of Masses on Christmas Morning, and issue tickets for those Masses. That way people will know if they do have a space for Mass at Seton, or they need to attend another Parish. With only 525 seats available, people have to know ahead of time if they can attend. Otherwise, you will have overcrowding, and turning

people away, which will result in grumpy Parishioners. This was discussed. It looks like, if all goes well, that we will be back in the church by the week before Christmas. We will take another look at our November 2nd meeting.
